Dorm Information



You will be provided with a bed, desk, chair, dresser, and small bookcase by the school. You may bring a hot pot, microwave, or small refrigerator for use in your room at no extra cost. Electric irons may not be used in your room; however, there are places provided in the dorms to iron your clothes. You are welcome to bring a stereo, but during study hours and after 10:00 PM, audio equipment must be used with headphones. You should not bring a TV or DVD player. DVD players in computers may not be used for entertainment. There is a movie area in the student center that can be used by students.

KMBC provides fast wireless internet access on the entire campus.

If you play any musical instruments please bring them along!
Be aware that instruments should not be played in the dormitory during study hours or after 10:00 PM.

Pets are not permitted in the dorm except for fish in aquariums.

In accordance with fire safety regulations, the following items are not permitted in the dorm:
the burning of incense, candles, or kerosene lamps;
any open flame or open hot plate cooking devices; space heaters.

Random Information you might be wondering:

Our dorms have central air conditioning. The beds fit twin or college (XL twin) bedsheets.

All food should be stored in covered metal or plastic containers.

There is a microwave and refrigerator on each hall for common use.

Cell-phone coverage is best from Appalachian Wireless, Verizon, US Cellular, and At&t, in that order.

Freshmen are allowed to have vehicles on campus.
