PERSUASION

The speaker will prepare and deliver a 3-5 minute persuasive presentation.

The speech should:

Be Motivational in nature Identify a spiritual/missional need and persuade others to get involved.

> The judges will evaluate the performance by a scoring guide.



WRITING

The author will submit a creative writing sample no more than 8 pages in length.

The writing should be:

- Inspirational in nature
- Submitted by April 15 to kmbc@kmbc.edu or kmbc.edu/got-talent The judges will evaluate writing selection by a scoring guide.



VOCAL SOLO

The singer will prepare a 3-5 minute song.

The song should:

Be Sacred or Worship in nature Use recorded or live accompaniment*

> > The judges will evaluate the performance by a scoring guide.



INSTRUMENTAL

The instrumentalist will prepare a 3-5 minute hymn or worship arrangement. The contestant may use recorded or live accompaniment*

DRAMA

The speaker will prepare and deliver a 3-5 minute drama

The speech should be a Drama, Mime, or Monologue and Christian in emphasis
