

# Visiting KMBC

DURING COVID-19

## *Before you Travel:*

- If you have an elevated temperature, or any symptoms of COVID-19, please contact us to reschedule your visit.
- If you are coming from a state that has a 15% or higher positive testing rate, we ask that you postpone your visit, or have a current negative COVID test before arriving on campus.

## *When You Arrive:*

- You must report to the Business office in the Paulo Administration Building upon your arrival. There you will be given a temperature check and a brief health screening. You will receive a visitor sticker indicating you have done your health screening.
- This must be repeated each day of your stay before interacting with any students, faculty, or staff. You must wear the sticker you are given in a visible area at all times.

## *During Your Stay:*

- Understand that you may not be able to access some buildings or areas of buildings due to COVID-19 restrictions. Please talk with your visit host before entering any area other than the main floor of campus buildings.
- You must wear a mask whenever you are unable to maintain social distancing of 6 feet.
- Masks are provided in the business office if you do not have one.
- Overnight visits in the dormitories are not available at this time. We can provide overnight guestroom accommodations for you and your family if needed.
